As our school moves towards becoming cashless, we kindly ask that cash payments are made only when absolutely necessary.

Payment is asked for as a contribution towards the trip, however if we do not receive enough contributions by the due date, the trip cannot go ahead. Contributions are non-refundable, unless the trip is cancelled by the school.
